ABOUT THE OPPORTUNITY

The Łáwíní Sásm̓ Beloved Children Haítzaqv̓la Nest has a temporary full-time job available for an ***Hailhzaqv Language Nest Assistant***.

The work term is scheduled to take place upon hiring (at earliest) and will continue until August 28, 2026, and is funded by the FNEC Mentor Work Placement program (**please see eligibility requirements*). The work schedule is Monday to Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. FNEC Mentor Work Placement's are designed to support individuals to build job skills while gaining meaningful employment that will support future employment opportunities.

The ***Hailhzaqv Language Nest Assistant*** will provide assistance and support to the Hailhzaqv Language Revitalization Program Manager. The assistance and support will include but is not limited to the following duties and responsibilities: assist with creating visual aides (power point presentations, colouring pages, and flashcards) and books to be used by the Hailhzaqv Language Nest Teachers, and assisting with singing and dancing at the Hailhzaqv Language Nest, and other related duties. The employee plays an important role in contributing to creating a safe and engaging learning environment that supports the revitalization of Haítzaqv̓la. The new employee will use classroom technology (e.g. Smart Board, Audacity, PowerPoint, and Haítzaqv̓la font) and will build new skills in these areas. Additional skill building will focus on communication, supporting workplace relationships, and time management.

ABOUT YOU

You are a First Nation's youth between the ages of 15 and 30 and you are resident in the community, and you are not currently in school. You demonstrate genuine interest in child and classroom learning, and you have good computer skills, and you can build positive relationships with co-workers and students. You are looking for a short-term job placement. ***You are interested in:***

- Language & Culture
- Developing Computer Skills
- Working with children

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- First Nations youth ordinarily resident on reserve or on community lands.
- Between the ages of 15 to 30 at the start of the program's activities.
- Mentored work placements are for youth who are: not in school, or are unemployed, or underemployed.
- High school diploma or GED required.
- Must be willing to train for skills, and to learn and apply Haítzaqv̓la teaching methodologies.
- Basic office software skills and Internet and email usage are necessary to complete the work.
- Good organizational, communication, and teamwork skills.
- Enthusiasm for working with children in a language and cultural setting.
- Patience, empathy, and enthusiasm for working with young children and supporting cultural language revitalization.
- Able to satisfactorily obtain and maintain a Police Information Check for working with children.



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We recognize the value of diverse educational experiences including cultural, academic, work, and lived experience. We encourage those who closely match the qualifications listed to apply. ***Heiltsuk members and Indigenous applicants are encouraged to apply.***

ABOUT THE COMPENSATION

The rate of pay is **\$21.00** per hour. Hours per week are 37.5 hours (75 hours bi-weekly). This role includes insurable employment hours under the Employment Insurance Act. EI eligibility is determined by Service Canada based on individual circumstances.
